12:15 PM - Central Daylight Time - 2 hr **Attraction #2- History and Lunch** Introducing the Southdown Plantation House/The Terrebonne Museum, a historic property that has been meticulously restored and expanded to offer visitors a glimpse into the rich history of the region. Originally added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1974, the property was granted tax-exempt status and donated to THACS by Valhi, Inc in 1975. Since then, the plantation house, servants quarters, and surrounding land have been renovated and opened to the public, with exhibits covering a range of topics. Additionally, a workers cabin from Hollywood Plantation has been restored and now houses an exhibit on life and labor in 1885. Come explore this fascinating piece of history today.
